DECISION

Pursuant to the provisions of Art. 151 item 4 taken together with art. 151 item 4h, Art. 157a item 6 taken together with art. 157a item 14, Art. 157g item 5 taken together with art. 157g item 13 of the Act of December 12 2013 on Foreigners (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 35 incl. further amendments) and Art. 104 § 1 of the Act of June 14, 1960 – Code of Administrative Procedure (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 256 incl. further amendments)

having considered

the motion of the Director of the National Institute of Geriatrics, Rheumatology, and Rehabilitation of Professor Eleonora Reicher in Warsaw

to approve the National Institute of Geriatrics, Rheumatology, and Rehabilitation of Prof. Eleonora Reicher in Warsaw for the purposes of accepting foreigners to conduct scientific research or development works, and

to approve the National Institute of Geriatrics, Rheumatology, and Rehabilitation of Prof. Eleonora Reicher to accept foreigners for the purposes of internship

to approve the National Institute of Geriatrics, Rheumatology, and Rehabilitation of Prof. Eleonora Reicher in Warsaw for the purposes of accepting foreigners as volunteers

I hereby decide to:

- approve the aforementioned research institution for the purposes of accepting foreigners for the purposes of conducting scientific research or development works. The unit shall be approved for a period of 5 years;
- 2). to approve the aforementioned organiser for the purposes of accepting foreigners for internships. The unit shall be approved for a period of 2 years;
- 3). to approve the aforementioned organisational unit for the purposes of accepting foreigners as volunteers. The unit shall be approved for a period of 2 years.

Pursuant to the provisions of Art. 107 § 4 of the Code of Administrative Procedure I hereby withdraw from providing grounds for the decision, as it satisfies all demands of the party.

INSTRUCTION

The recipient does not have the right to appeal against this decision. However, if the party is not satisfied with the decision, it may file a motion to reconsider the case to the Minister of Internal Affairs and Administration within 14 days from the date of delivery of the decision, pursuant to Art. 127 § 3 of the Act of June 14, 1960 – Code of Administrative Procedure (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 256 incl. further amendments),

Pursuant to the provisions of Art. 127a § 1 and § 2 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, taken together with Art. 127 § 3 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, during the period of appeal the party may waive the right to file a motion to reconsider the case to the public administration body that issued the Decision. On the day of delivery of the statement on waiver of the right to file the motion to reconsider the case by the last party to the proceedings, the decision becomes valid and binding.

Pursuant to the provisions of Art. 127a § 1 and § 2 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, taken together with Art. 127 § 3 of Code of Administrative Procedure, during the period of appeal the party may waive the right to file a motion to reconsider the case to the public administration body that issued the Decision. On the day of delivery of the statement on waiver of the right to file a motion to reconsider the case by the last party to the proceedings, the decision becomes valid and binding.

If the party does not wish to exercise the right to file a motion to reconsider the case, it may lodge a complaint against the decision to the Voivodeship Administrative Court in Warsaw through the Minister of Internal Affairs and Administration, within 30 days from the date of delivery of the decision (art. 3 § 2 (1), art. 13 and art. 52 § 3 of the Act of August 30, 2002 – Law – Proceedings before Administrative Courts (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1302, incl. amendments, hereinafter: PAC Law. The fee for lodging the complaint is PLN 100 (in the extraordinary modes of the Code of Administrative Procedure – PLN 200).

The complaining party may apply for granting the right to support (art. 243-262 of the PAC Law) including to be exempt from the duty to pay court fees.
